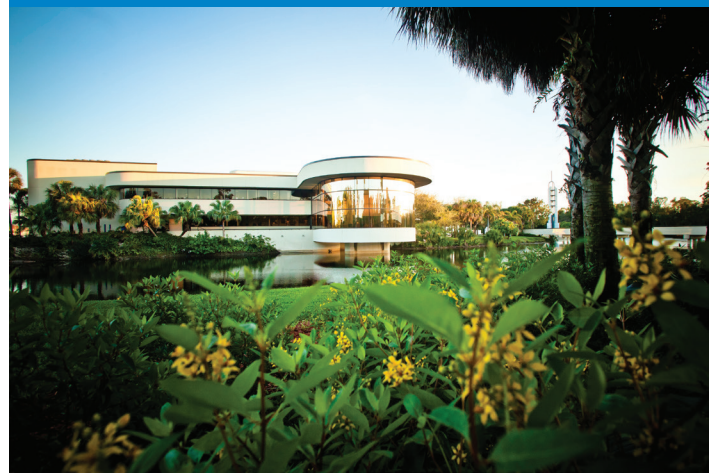
Tire Leadership 21 is based on Northwood's Executive MBA program, combined with industry-specific faculty and subjects.
